Day-to-day activities will vary between working in I-DEV's local office, attending meetings with other development organizations, government agencies, and the I-DEV project team, and working in-the-field directly with I-DEV's project team and local communities. Primary responsibilities will be to manage the in-depth industry due diligence process, develop financial models, conduct detailed research and interviews, provide clients with management & financial strategy advice, and analyze business development opportunities. **The position will also likely involve a great deal international travel to developing countries around the world.**

### Qualifications:

#### **Fellow/ Field Consultant Positions:**

Applicants interested in applying for I-DEV's Fellowship Program as **Field Consultants** must have at least 2 years of experience in the traditional business sector, preferably investment banking, management consulting, accounting, or other similar positions (***or alternatively an MBA, or similar masters degree***), as well as strong financial modeling, industry research and business analysis skills. A preference will be given to applicants who have significant field experience as well, such as Peace Corps Volunteers with previous business sector backgrounds.

Applicants must demonstrate an established record of professional achievement and integrity, and the capacity for critical, creative, and **entrepreneurial** thinking. Further, applicants should demonstrate a commitment to I-DEV's mission. **Applicants must be willing to live in rural regions of developing countries and be fluent in Spanish.**
