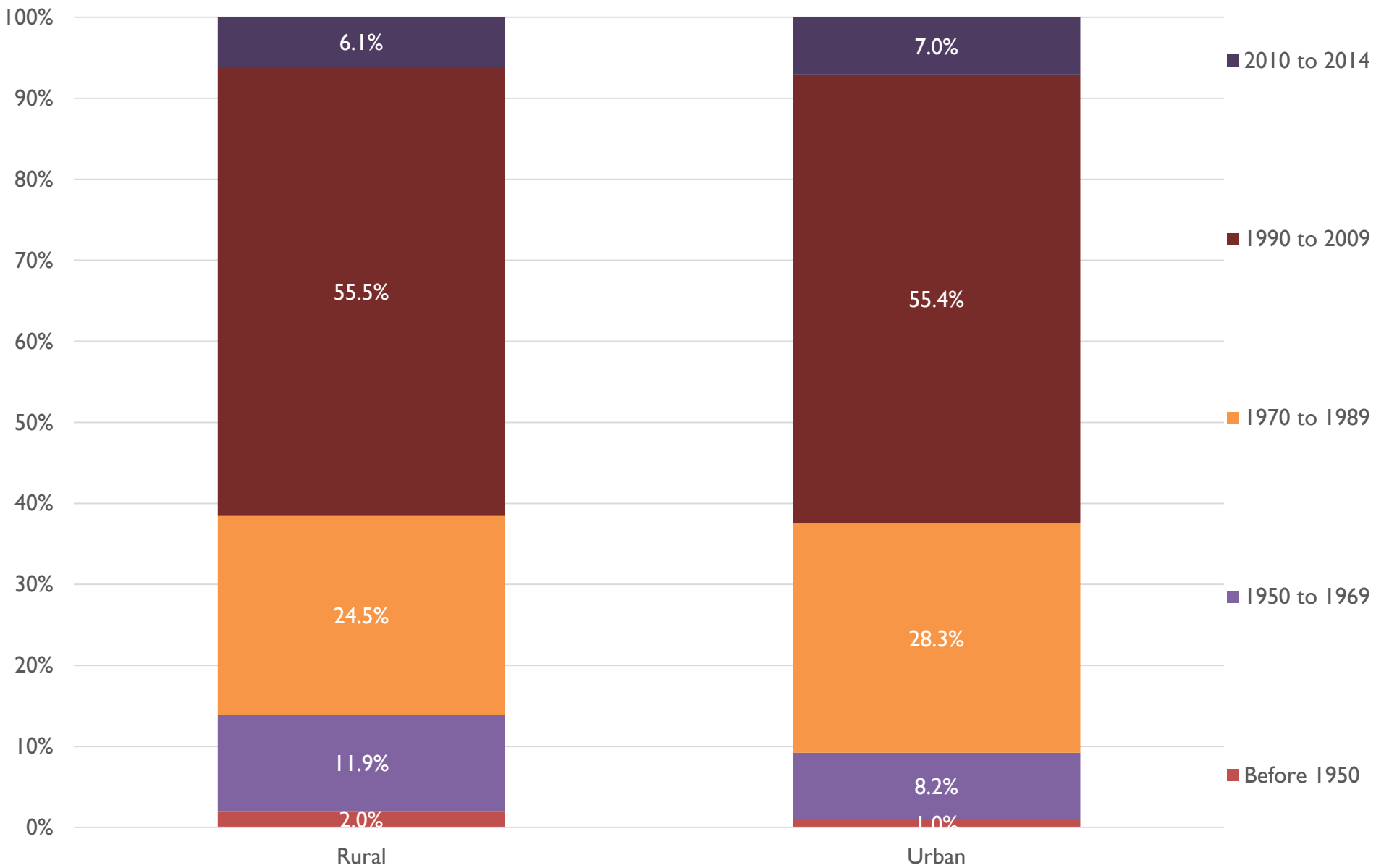

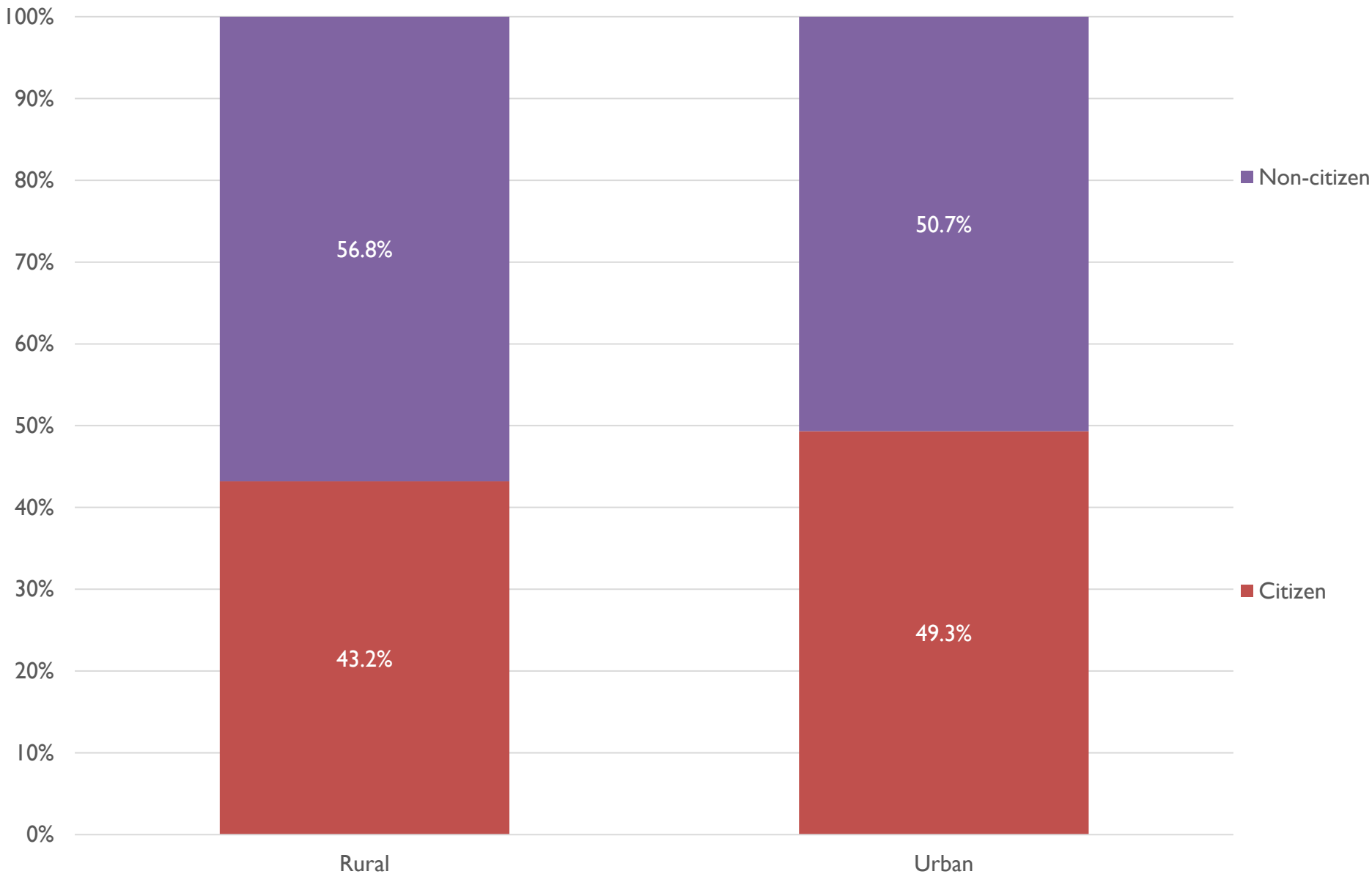

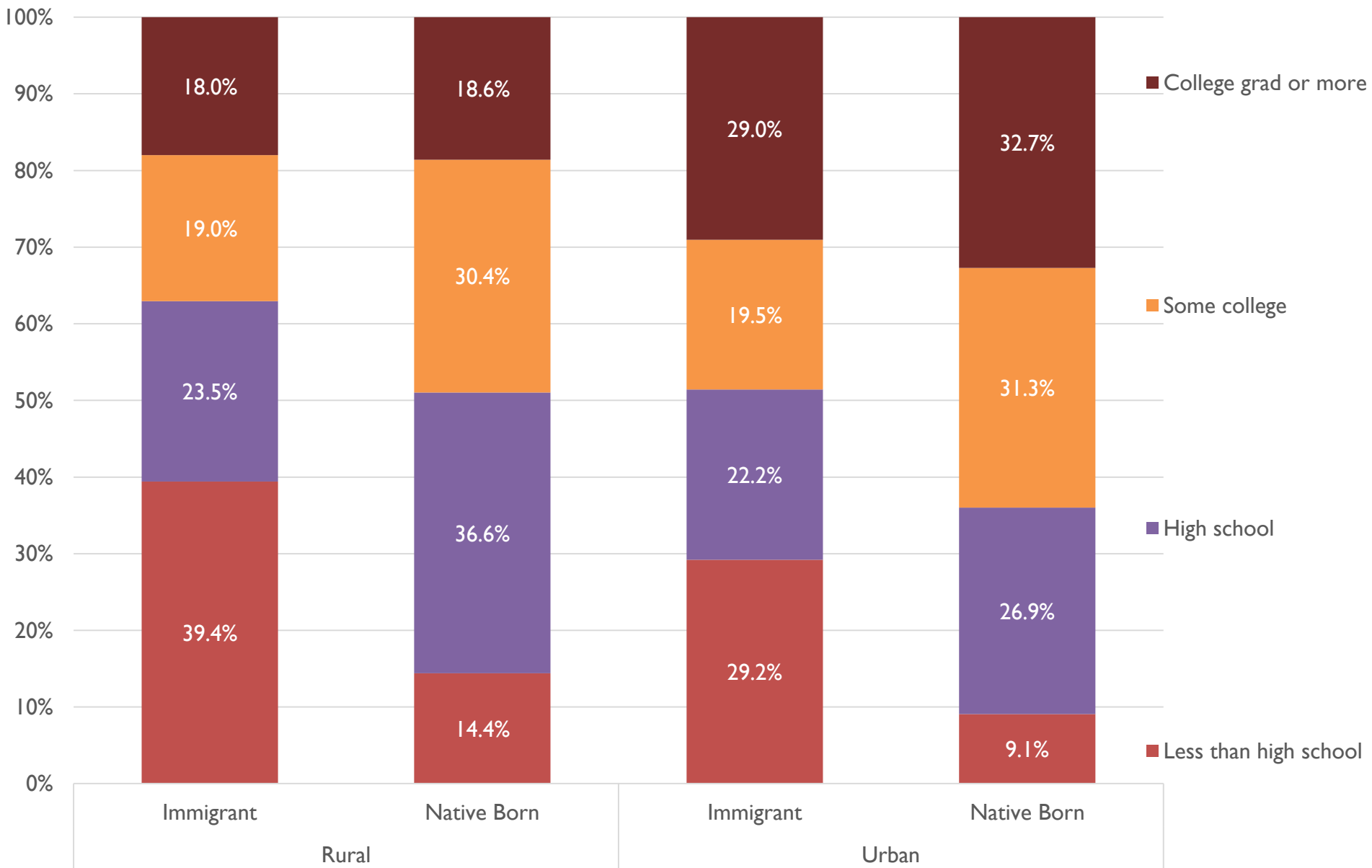

Educational Attainment by Nativity and Metropolitan Status

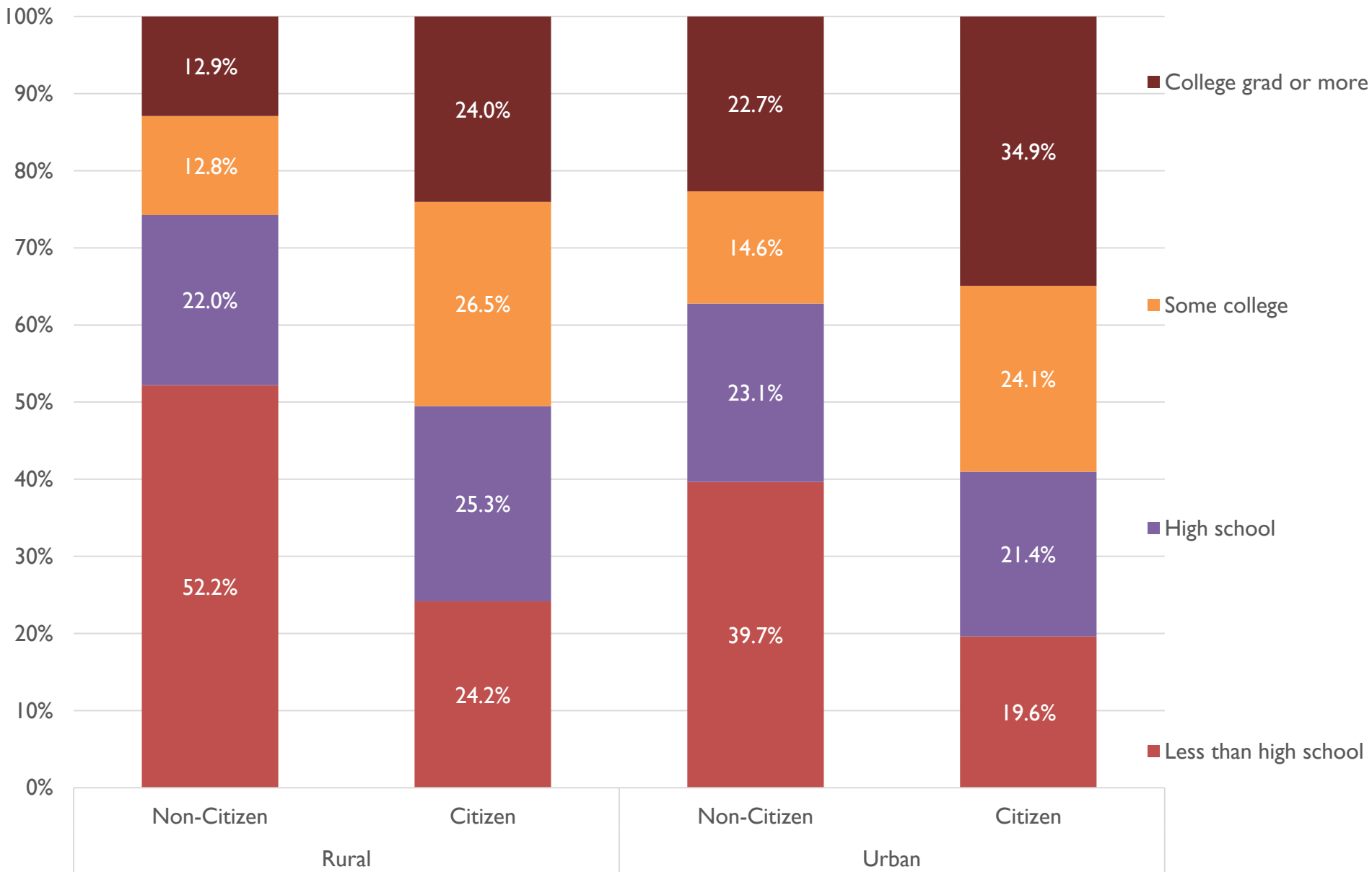

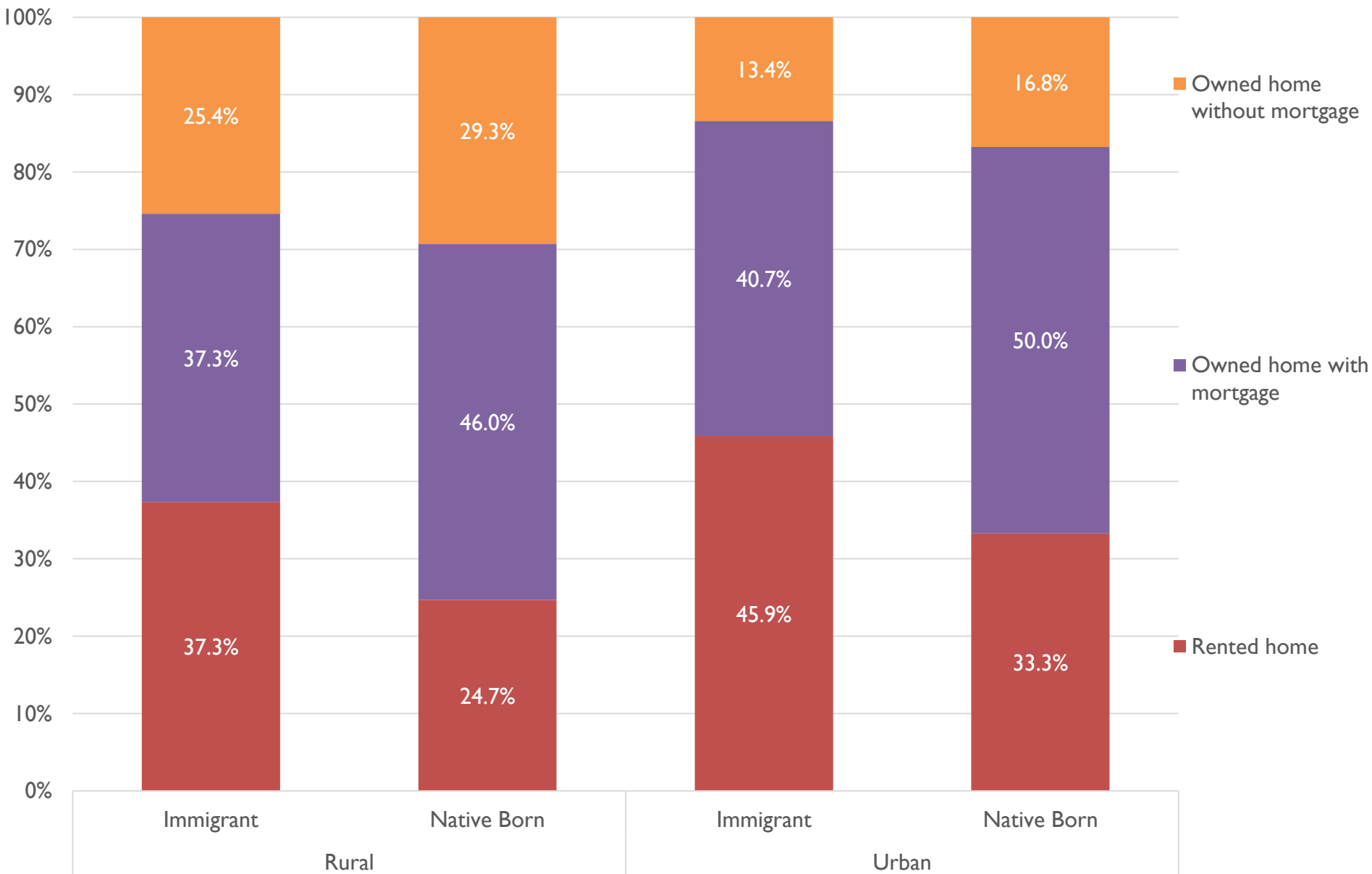

Home Ownership by Nativity and Metropolitan Status



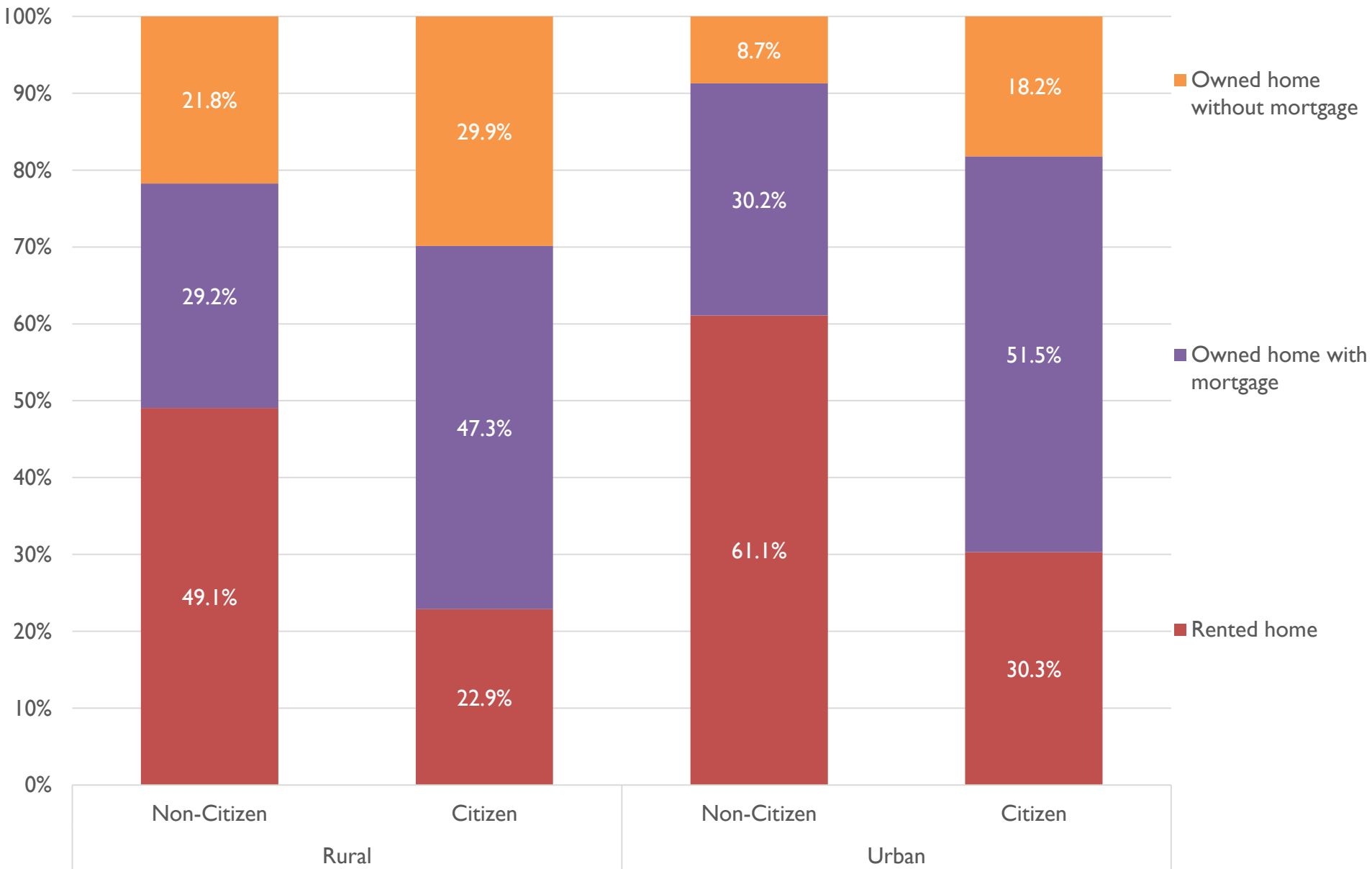

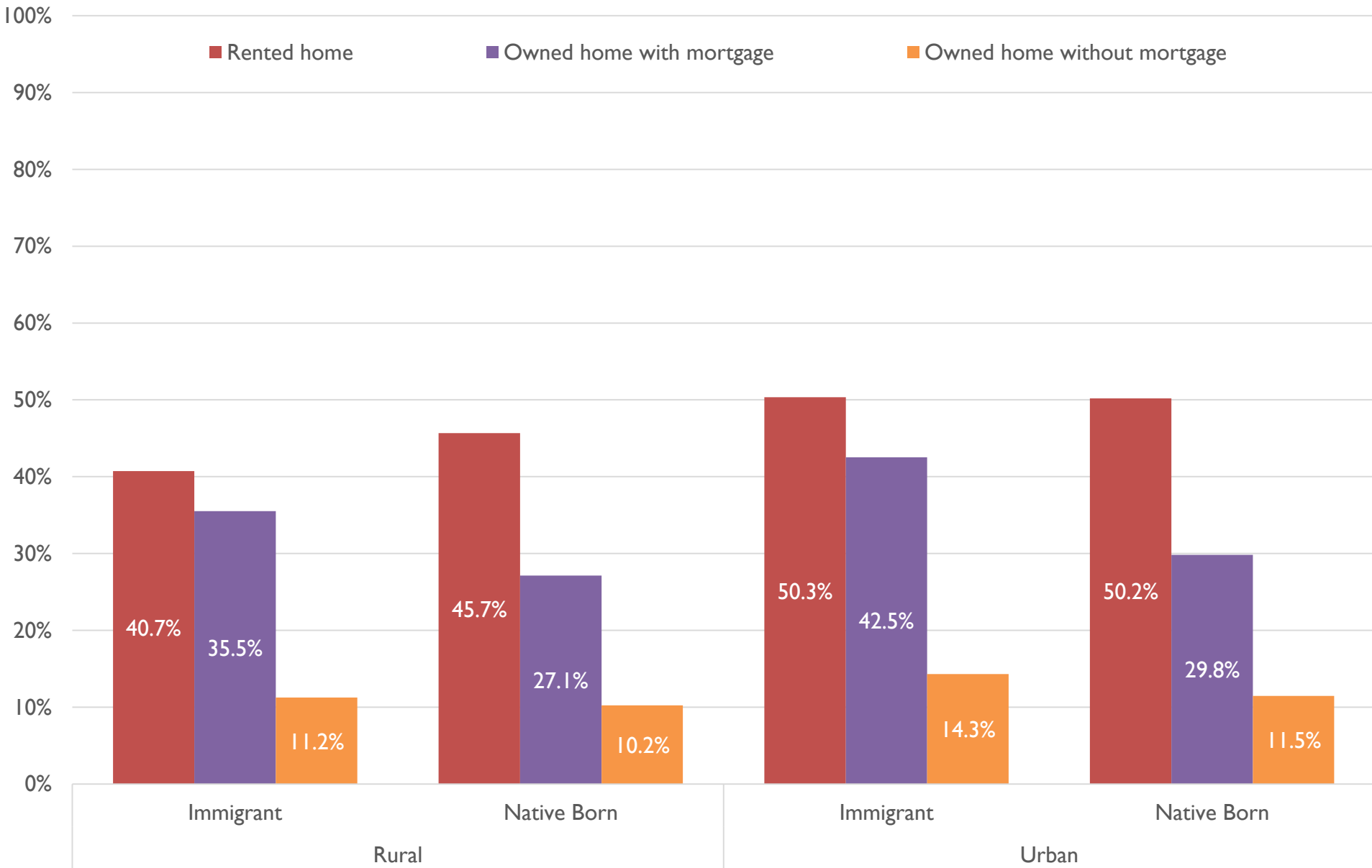

Housing-Cost Burden

- A comparison of total household income to total costs to maintain an owned home (or gross rent in a rented home).
- The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) considers individuals living in homes where more than 30 percent of total household income goes to housing costs to be “housing-cost” burdened.
- The figures in the following section display the percent of people who are housing cost burdened.



Housing-Cost Burden by Nativity and Metropolitan Status

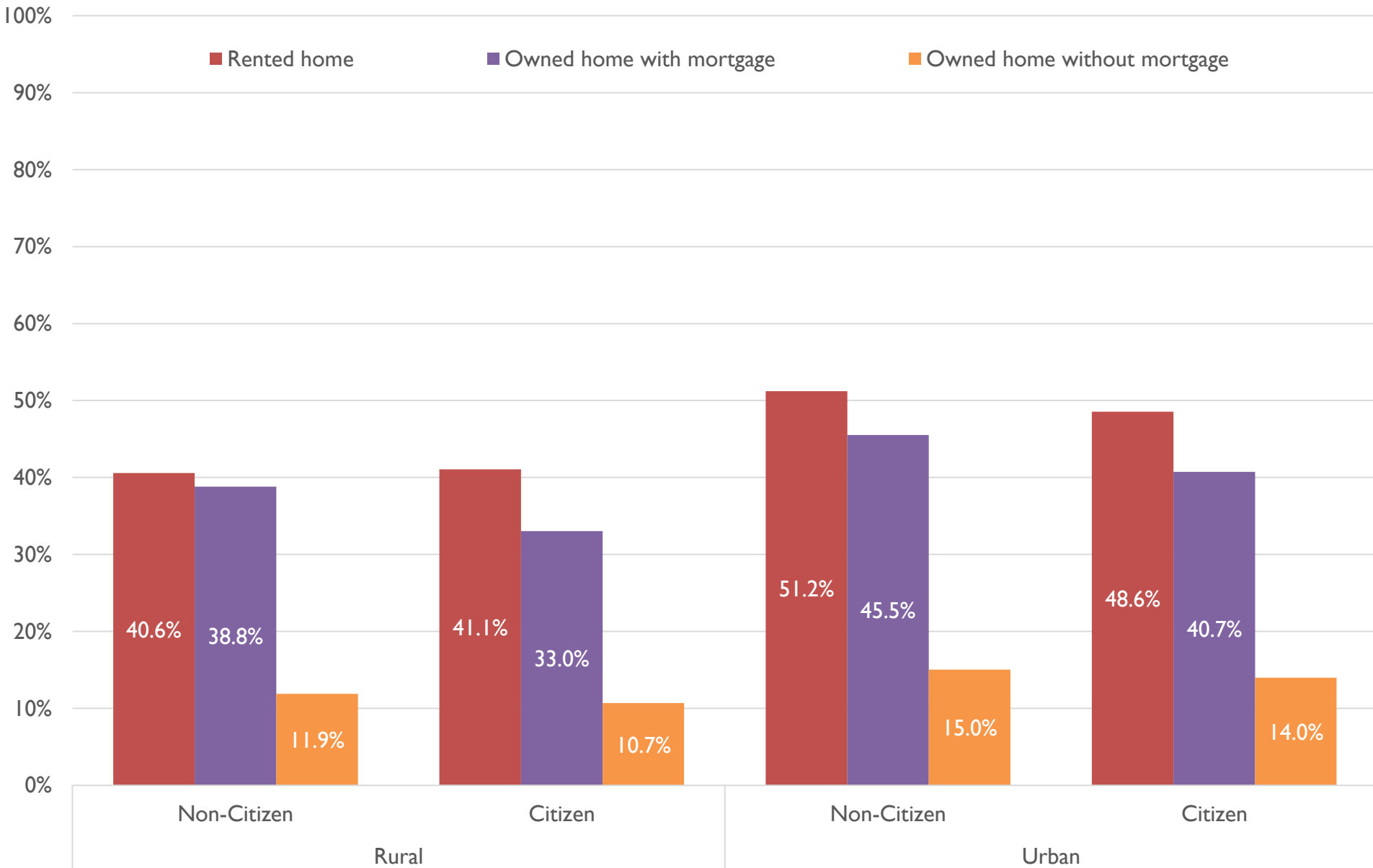
