






EU energy demand 2014-2050 TPED, billion toe











Efficiency targets squeezing oil & gas demand...






Renewable share of EU electricity generation has nearly doubled in past decade





Sources of gas supply – back to the Energy Union....




Russian pipeline gas and LNG exports in *Reform* Billion cubic meters


