Global Changemakers Workshop

Since 2023, the Global Changemakers Workshop Series has become a key part of the Aspen Institute International Partners' network efforts to empower the next generation of leaders to focus on the challenges to democracy and inspire values-based leadership.

This year, 19 young leaders from 15 countries were selected to gather together in Warsaw, Poland to tackle one of the most pressing global challenges: building a greener, more secure, and just future with critical minerals.
